What a week we have had! On Wednesday we had a fire drill run through, on Thursday we had an AMAZING day at Wisley and today (Friday) we had another visit from the police, this time from the Metropolitan Police. We were able to go inside their van and try on lots of equipment. We had lots of questions for the officers.

This week's learning:

In Phonics, we continued to review all previously taught sounds and harder to read and spell words. We introduced new harder to read and spell words; children, love. In Literacy, we learnt about the people who would help us at Wisley (our school trip on Thursday). We wrote a sentence about how they keep us safe. In Maths, we have been comparing length using mathematical vocabulary to describe. In PSED, we have been learning about the importance of washing our hands and keeping healthy. In PD, the children played games to teach them about the space around them, some of the games were 'freeze and fire' and 'tag'.

Next week's learning:

In Phonics, we will continue to review all previously taught sounds and harder to read and spell words. In Literacy/Understanding the World, we will be learning about why Christians celebrate Easter. We will be decorating and writing an Easter card for our families. In Maths, we will be comparing and ordering height using mathematical vocabulary to describe (short/shortest, tall/tallest. In PSED, we will be learning about safe adults and what to do if we are ever not with our safe adult. In PD, the children will be learning to transport hoops with control by rolling, spinning, throwing and rotating.
