

Dear Parents / Carers,

What another fantastic week we have had in Year 3! The children have been working extremely hard - we are very proud of them.

In English this week, the children have been inventing their own story based on The Owl who was afraid of the dark, with a continued focus on possessive apostrophes. Next week, the children will have a go at doing some creative writing, based on some picture prompts. We will recap three skills that we have previously learnt.

In Maths, we have continued learning about fractions. The children have done really well with this so far. Next week, we will continue our work on fractions.

# Learning For Life

In Learning for Life this week, we have been discussing how to keep our bodies healthy. Part of this discussion was around drugs (both legal medicines etc and illegal drugs). The children showed curiosity and maturity when discussing this in class. The children have learnt that some drugs can make us feel better when we are poorly, however we should only take what we have been prescribed under the supervision of a trusted adult. The children have also talked about illegal or unhealthy drugs (e.g. cigarettes) and what they would do if they found something unknown (call the police!).
