What could the temperature be on Tuesday?

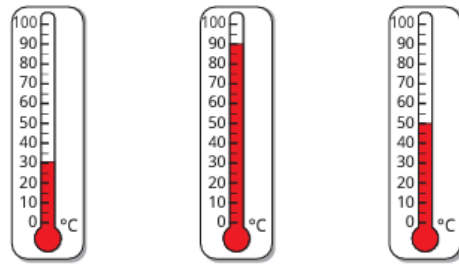
