Our learning

After half term, we will be encouraging the children to show off their best learning and all that they have learnt with us within this milestone. We will be completing some special booklets from NTS that will help us understand what small steps the children need to take next and to celebrate what they can already do. These will include a reading paper with some unseen text and some maths papers, including arithmetic and reasoning.

For Week 1 in our learning of the Summer Term, we will compare and order mixed numbers and start to understand what improper fractions are in **Maths.**

In **English**, we will begin to research endangered animals and start to use the present perfect tense. In **Foundation**, we will begin our badminton sessions, explore what jealousy is in Learning for Life and use maps to locate features of our local area in Geography.
