EURO 2024 FINAL

You will need to register an account before you are able to make a comment on the application. Once you have an account (which will take a couple of minutes), you will need to search for our application by using the school name or application number 24/P/01007. Once you have found the application, you simply make a comment. I promise that it will only take a few minutes and by doing so, you will be sharing your views directly with the Guildford Borough Council. By taking action now, we may have a chance to install our MUGA by Christmas! Currently there are 9 comments – 8 supporting and 1 objecting. **Planning officers will review comments by the end of July so it is vital that you act quickly!** Furthermore, if you are part of a club or know of an organisation who would be interested in renting our MUGA in future, please contact me directly. I already have three firm bookings!
