

<p>As scientists...</p>	<p>we will be learning about skeletons (both human and animal) as well the movement of the body.</p>	
<p>As computing experts...</p>	<p>we will be reminding ourselves how to stay safe online. We will use Purple Mash to develop our coding skills.</p>	
<p>As geographers...</p>	<p>we will be using atlases for find out about mountain ranges within the UK and around the world. We will also be researching how mountains are formed and about life on the mountains.</p>
