

**WORPLESDON PRIMARY SCHOOL**  
**Year 6 Residential Educational Visit**  
**Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> July-Friday 10<sup>th</sup> July 2026**

Dear Parents/carers,

The Year 6 residential is always one of the highlights of a child's career at Worplesdon and this year, we are visiting Stubbers Adventure Centre, located in Essex. Due to the cost of living increase, we have made the difficult decision to opt for a 2 night stay again this year. Alongside this, we will organise other days which include fun and memorable activities for the children, which will take place at school.

**Location: Stubbers Adventure Centre,**  
**Ockendon Road, Upminster,**  
**Essex, RM14 2TY**

**Length of visit:** 3 days/2 nights

**Purpose of visit:**

- To develop resilience and teamwork skills.
- To provide a memorable and fun experience
- To develop the children's social skills and independence.

**Dates:** Wednesday 8th July-Friday 10th July 2026

**Itinerary:**

All children will be following the same itinerary, on a rotational basis. There are many activities on offer including climbing, high ropes, paddle boarding, laser tag & archery. There will also be evening activities which may include a disco and/or camp fire experience. Our final timetable is not yet finalised but when we have our parents meeting closer to the time of our visit, we will be able to share this with you.

**Accommodation & Food:**

Stubbers Adventure Centre is a place where you can run, jump, drive, navigate, shoot, sail, paddle, climb, build! Stubbers is set on a 130-acre site and has been there for 20 years. Their highly-trained, passionate staff are committed to introducing the children to new skills and experiences and making sure they have a whole lot of fun! Luckily, Worplesdon will have a camp to ourselves. Every bunkhouse tent can comfortably house 10 young people in bunks with full mattresses and sheets – all the children need to bring is a sleeping bag and pillow.

Fun may be important, but so is food, and we want to ensure the children continue to have access to a healthy and balanced meal plan during our stay. Stubbers Adventure centre serve three meals per day. There is a canteen style food service in their dining rooms; they serve generous portions of fruit and veg with meals, with a self-serve salad bar at lunch and dinner time too. All the chicken served at

Stubbers Adventure Centre is Halal and the kitchen is nut free. Options are always provided for children with specific dietary needs.

#### **Transport:**

Transport will be by coach. We will be transported to Stubbers Adventure Centre by coach and then collected on Wednesday for the return journey.

#### **Cost:**

The cost of the residential trip is £293, which is inclusive of transport, accommodation, all activities and food. Our decision to opt for a 2-night stay this year has reduced the price significantly than if we were to have chosen a 4-night stay. It is our aim to take **every child** on this educational visit, so we hope this will help to allow that. We must however, cover our costs in order for the visit to go ahead. Therefore, it is necessary to request a voluntary contribution from each family for the full amount of the cost per child. If you would like your child to go but may have difficulty finding all the contribution please do not hesitate to speak to your child's class teacher, Mrs O'Brien or Mrs Woodruff.

We would ask that you please pay this voluntary donation via your child's Parentmail account. If you have not yet set up your child's account, please see the office as soon as possible. The required consent for your child to attend the trip is also made through your Parentmail account at the time of paying so please ensure you tick the relevant tick box at the time you make your deposit. Your child will not be allowed on the trip if you have not given this consent.

**To secure your child's place on the trip, please ensure the non-refundable deposit along with your consent is received via your child's Parentmail account by Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> October 2025.**

The cost can be paid online via Parentmail in a few ways:

#### **By instalments in line with the dates set out below:**

1. *Non-refundable deposit of £50 by Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> October 2025*
2. *Payment of £40.50 by Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> November 2025*
3. *Payment of £40.50 by Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> December 2025*
4. *Payment of £40.50 by Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> January 2026*
5. *Payment of £40.50 by Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> February 2026*
6. *Payment of £40.50 by Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> March 2026*
7. *Final payment of £40.50 by Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> April 2026*

**Payment of the full amount (minus the deposit) by Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> April 2026.**

*i.e. £50 deposit paid and remaining £243 to be paid by Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> April 2026.*

*It would be appreciated if the payments could be made on the dates shown.*
