wild – not looked after by humans

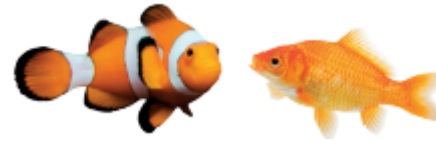
pet – looked after by humans
