Vocabulary

1. **Village** - A small settlement that can have between 100 and approximately 3,000 people.
2. **Town** - A mid-sized settlement that can have between 1,000 and 100,000 people.
3. **City** - A city is a large settlement that usually has more than 100,000 people.
4. **Coastal** - a place linked to the seaside
5. **Rural** - a place linked to the countryside



Coastal:

Seaside, boats, lighthouse, beach, sea, harbour



Rural:

Countryside, farm, tractor, village, trees



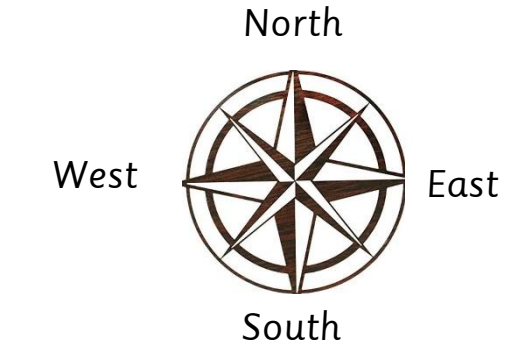
Village

Town

Lots of houses, schools, shops, restaurants, places of worship, a hospital

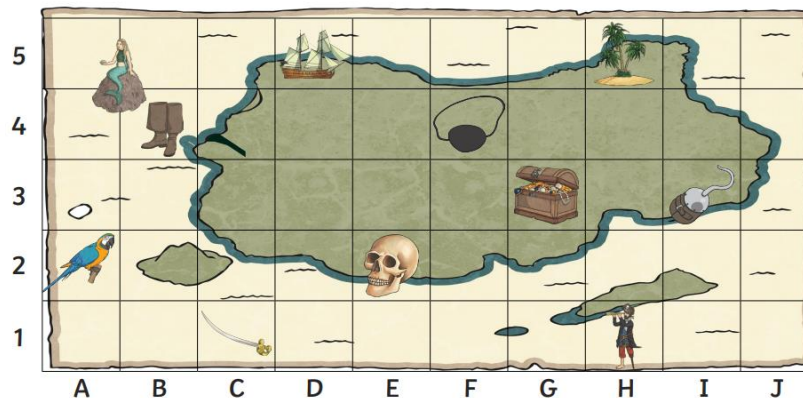


City
