

## Glossary

A covenant is...	An agreement that establishes a relationship – for example a marriage. Covenants in the Bible are promises made by God to a specific person or group of people.
The 10 Commandments are...	A set of rules given to Moses by God explaining how Christians must live.
The Bible is...	The Christian Holy book.
Jesus is ...	The son of God.
Christians are...	People who believe in Jesus and believe that the Bible is the word of God.
The Old Testament is...	The first part of the Bible, written before the time of Jesus.
The New Testament is...	The second part of the Bible, it documents Jesus' life and His miracles.

## Year 4 Autumn 2 RE: What did God promise to His people?

God made 4 key covenants in the Bible.

### Covenant One

With Noah – God promised Noah that He would never again send a flood to destroy the Earth because Noah had been faithful to God and done as God had asked through building the ark and protecting God's creation of living creatures.



### Covenant Two

With Abraham – God promised Abraham that if he was patient, he would have lots of children (which Abraham wanted) and that God would bless Abraham and his wife.



### Covenant Three

With Moses – God promised Moses that there was a promised land for the Christian people, Moses had to trust God to lead him through the desert to the promised land.



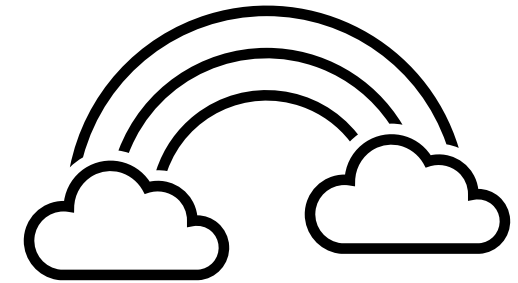
### Covenant Four

With David – God promised David that the Messiah would come from David's family because he had been a peaceful king.
