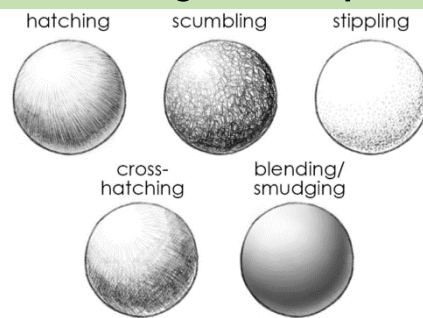

Georgia O'Keefe's inspiration

- Georgia O'Keefe painted nature in a way that showed how it made her feel.
- She is best known for her paintings of flowers and desert landscapes.
- O'Keefe did this by simplifying shapes and forms; she was called a pioneer.
- O'Keefe discovered Arthur Wesley's work in 1912, who focused on composition (which means how you arrange shapes and colours).

Vocabulary

- **Tones** - refers to how light or dark something is.
- **Tints** - where an artist adds a colour to white to create a lighter version of the colour.
- **Stippling** - a drawing technique in which areas of light and shadow are created using nothing but dots.
- **Abstract** - art that does not attempt to represent an accurate depiction of a visual reality but instead uses shapes, colours, forms and gestural marks to achieve its effect.
