## Vocabulary

<b>Refugee</b>	A child or family seeking safety in another country to escape conflict
<b>Prejudice</b>	When someone is unkind because of someone's beliefs
<b>Participation</b>	Joining in a group or community
<b>Persecution</b>	When someone is legally punished for bad behaviour
<b>Conflict</b>	War or fight due to a differing opinion
<b>Migrant</b>	Someone who moves from one place to another for a better life or for work
<b>Privilege</b>	When someone has many things
<b>Deprive</b>	When a person doesn't have their basic needs met
<b>Cooperation</b>	Working together
<b>Asylum</b>	Someone who is seeking safety in a country from conflict
<b>Citizen</b>	Someone who has legal documents proving they are from a country
<b>Collective decision</b>	When a group of people or government decides on something together
